The V3.0.0 new features include:

- New Map function based on OpenStreetMap
- Search function for Tree (Ctrl-F)
- Unified Watchdog and Server Maintenance Tool
- Databroker for enhanced performance
- 64-bit Server Core Components
- Microsoft Windows Server 2016 Compatible
- Support of Firebird Database V2.5.6 64-bit
- Support of OpenVPN server version 2.4.1



Also included in this release:

General

- A.I.M.O.S. V3 is available under the newly introduced subscription license as well as the perpetual license
- NE configuration backups are now stored in the server file system.
- ION-U LP US i-POI types are now supported by A.I.M.O.S. and the transition from Attenuation to Gain values is implemented.
- For newer i-POI types, the Service view on the ION-U HW/RF tab was incorrect for multiple services or bands. With the new release, this was corrected.
- The ION-U Remote Units band names were added in the HW/RF tab.
- ION-E CAP-L is supported.
- Node AM: a GPS Flag alarm and bulk scheduled action is now available

Security

- For security reasons, the access to VISU clients from different computers was reworked and can be restricted to one login per account.
- Support of OpenVPN server version 2.4.1 with encryption AES-256-CBC
- SNMP Community public removed on northbound interface
- A.I.M.O.S. disables the unsecure SMB V1
